Obviously, water baptism, by itself, does not save. One must **HEAR** the Word (John 6:46-47; Rom. 10:17). One must **BELIEVE** that Jesus is the Son of God (Heb. 11:6; John 8:24). One must **REPENT** of their sins (Luke 13:3; Acts 17:30). One must **CONFESS** faith that Jesus is the Son of God (Matt. 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Rom. 10:9-10). But, **WATER BAPTISM** is the step that takes one that is OUT of Christ and puts him INTO Christ (Rom. 6:3; Gal. 3:27). No one, dead or alive, can take the Scriptures and show otherwise. Yet multiplied millions deny the obvious and blindly fight against the Lord's own words. *"He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved"* (Mark 16:16). *"Why call me Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say"* (Luke 6:46)? Will YOU go to judgment fighting against the Lord? In baptism, one contacts the blood of Christ that washes sins away (1 Peter 3:21). —Garland M. Robinson
